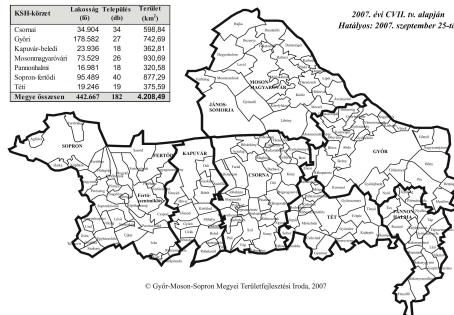

- 82% of about 25 000 microregional enterprises concentrated in Győr
- Automobile cluster
