

Overall, long-term objectives

The project objective is to create the concept of spatial arrangement of the Danube area, an interregional level, in form of the common-oriented territorial planning, economic and socially the most effective development potentials of the Danube region or a broader interregional context.

The partial project objectives are:

1. to create a basis for the preparation of territorial technical, social-economic and socio-economic relations of territorial units along the Danube river
2. to create a basis for the establishment of the common development territories along the Danube
3. to create the key information base on which the public, administrative authorities in the Danube area may rely when defining their own policies, regional plans and development
4. to create conditions for the interagency ability to handle the potential transferable solutions, as well as the possibility of providing information to the banking and financial institutions
