## 1<sup>st</sup> Step

### Data collection and systematization

For the data collection and systematization the following steps should be realized:

- To agree the formats of data collection in the Donauregionen project as a basis of data collection (data types, basic characteristics and parameters of information formats, basic software);
- To identify the sources of information (organizations, information web-resources, etc.);
- To organize the process of data obtaining and its transformation to the forms accepted in the Donauregionen project
- To agree the procedure of the information updating (use of services of subcontractors for obtaining of the information)
- Integration of the collected data to the GIS

*We believe that consistent and rigorous implementation of these steps will lead to the acquisition of the objective and reliable data of the RMU region which can be introduced into the overall information environment.*
