
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NUTS4 in D+ aria

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- In last 2 year's in Tehnical infrastructure was approved - Regulations for the supply and use of electricity, Regulation on Quality of electricity distribution and supply, Regulation for the provision and use of natural gas, etc.
- Country development strategies clearly establish the priority of industrialization by promoting the creation of free economic zones and industrial parks.

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
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Total Investment in FEZs up to 2009 (USD million)

- In order to improve the training of young generation and enhance the competitiveness of graduates on national and international labor market modernization was elaborated Program for development educational system in Moldova (2005-2008)

- National Programme for the recovery of industrial and domestic (PNVDPM).
- National strategy on how to reduce and eliminate persistent organic pollutants.
- Concept sanitation localities in Moldova.

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4th step - Donauregion and the European Development Policies

- 28 November 1994 – Moldova was signed the Partnership and Cooperation Agreement – PCA by EU
- In February 2005 - the Action Plan EU - Moldova
- January 1, 2008 - the Brussels Agreement on visa facilitation and readmission agreement
- the end of 2010 will be completed EU *Strategy for the Danube Region*, a regional development model at European level

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5th step - Analysis of several transnational initiatives
